

S&P Nov U.S. Acreage Update

Date: Thursday, November 14, 2024 at 11:55 AM EST

- US 2024 planted acreage prospects have been reviewed with adjustments made corn, sorghum, winter wheat, soybeans, sunflowers, and upland cotton.
- The S&P Global Commodity Insights November winter wheat survey showed a decrease in 2025 planted area. We lowered our winter wheat planted area forecast 500,000 acres to 33.0 million.
- All adjustments made to other crops were made based on economic analysis and historic acreage.
- US corn acreage for 2025 is projected to total 93.5 million, up 1.5 million from our October projection and 2.75 million above 2024.
- US soybean acreage for 2025 is projected to total 84.0 million, down 1.5 million from our October projection and 3.1 million below 2024.
- US all wheat acreage for 2025 is projected to total 46.3 million, down 500,000 from our October projection but 221,000 above 2024.
- US all cotton acreage for 2025 is projected to total 10.9 million, down 300,000 from our October projection and 275,000 below 2024.
